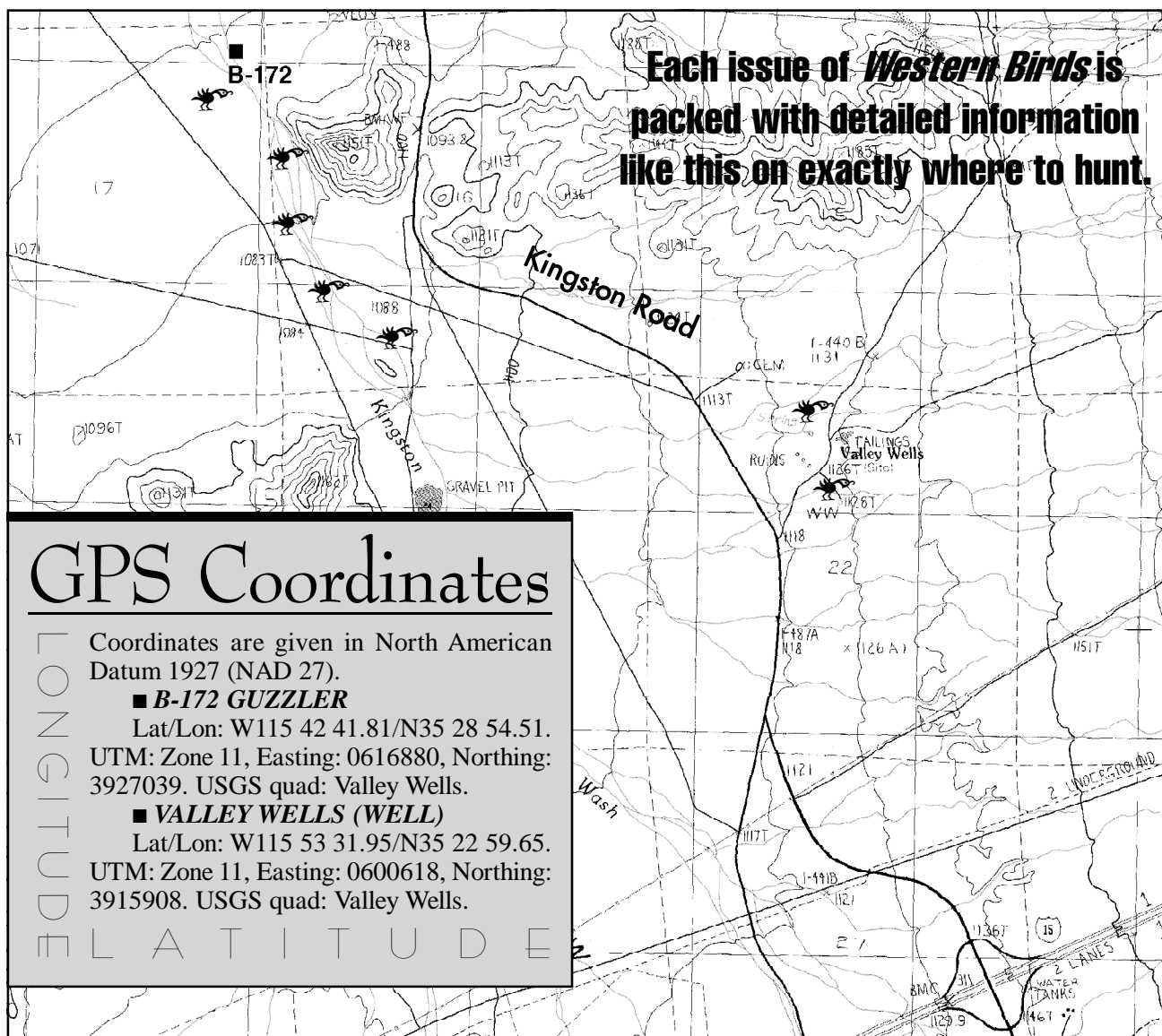
of the mountain knob you can see on the map.

Kingston Wash is a main flyway for doves, and I saw birds everywhere all along this wash above and below the guzzler. There were also quail scattered throughout this area and they were calling from all directions. I saw **five coveys** between B-172 and the paved Kingston Road along about two miles of dirt road.

There were also quail and doves all around Valley Wells, even though I couldn't find any surface water when I was there in August.



Guzzler B-172, which was full in August, is on the edge of Kingston Wash north of Interstate 15 at the Cima Road exit.



Guzzler B-172 and Valley Wells are just north of I-15. The map is a portion of the Valley Wells USGS 7 1/2-minute quad.
